

Induscan QC Technician (Crash course) (IQCT-C)

Eligibility criteria for course admission

The applicant shall have passed PLUS TWO (in any discipline) from a government-approved higher secondary school and shall have a minimum of two years' relevant experience in mechanical construction or a production company. Registration fee is Rs 1000/- (Rupees one thousand only). An online registration form is available on our website.

Pre-admission counselling

Pre-admission counselling (one day) will be arranged at the institute to explain the course content, course benefits, course fee, joining process, methodology of training, employment, answers to questions, etc. Counselling dates will be published as per the schedule of batches.

The course

The selected student should undergo the four modules (Modules 1, 2, 3 and 4) of the training programme to complete the studies. During this period, the student undergoes practical-oriented training on various concepts of engineering such as engineering drawings, materials identification, material handling, metallurgy, manufacturing processes (marking, cutting, drilling, steel structural fabrication, piping fabrication, welding, process NDT, quality control tests, maintenance, industrial safety and disaster management) at the level of a technician.

Duration and methodology

The duration of training is 200 hours (34 working days @ 6 hours a day). The methodology of study is 30% theory and 70% practical classes.
