Eligibility - Diploma students

The applicant shall have completed the First, Second or Third Year of a Diploma in Mechanical / Electrical / Civil Engineering from a government-approved Polytechnic College, shall have approval from college authorities, and shall agree with the subject / syllabus of the internship or with Induscan's internship syllabus. An online registration form is available on our website.

Eligibility - B.Tech students

The applicant shall have completed the First, Second or Third Year of B.Tech in Mechanical / Electrical / Civil Engineering from a government-approved Engineering College, shall have approval from college authorities, and shall agree with the subject / syllabus of the internship or with Induscan's internship syllabus. An online registration form is available on our website.

Pre-admission counselling

The internship programme

Diploma students undergo two Modules (Module 1 for Second Year; Module 2 for Third Year). B.Tech students undergo three Modules (Module 1 for Second Year; Module 2 for Third Year; Module 3 for Fourth Year). During this period, students undergo hands-on practical training in the manufacturing unit of Induscan Infrastructure.
